Creativity, Anthropomorphization, and Uncanny Valley

In this talk I address the contentious topic of computational creativity through an analysis of the public perceptions, opinions, and attitudes in relation to the use of AI in the creative sector. To this end, in the central part of the talk I present a survey designed and conducted to explore how contemporary audiences perceive the role and value of AI in the context of creativity. What emerges from the results of this study is an overwhelming opposition against the diffusion of AI systems in the creative sector. I consider how a possible cause of this discontent is the fact that state-of-the-art AI does not correspond to the mental model of AI that fictional narratives and media headlines lead us to form. I close the talk by discussing what this suggests in terms of future directions of AI research.
